

cream required access to both ice and expensive ingredients.



# Easing kids back into school

# Why you need a divorce financial order to cut all ties with you ex

The landmark case of Wyatt v Vince, where the multimillionaire windfarm tycoon's ex-wife made a successful financial claim 20 years after the divorce, should act as a cautionary tale for anyone thinking of a DIY divorce, Dipika Mistry, Legal Director at Solihull-based law firm, Shakespeare Martineau, explains...

### **Final Order Is Not Enough**

A lot of couples who undertake DIY divorces fall into the trap of thinking that the divorce date – or final order – is the end. A divorce final order is NOT a clean break financial order. In reality, without proper protection, financial claims can be made many years later.

### **Consent Orders**

A Consent Order is a document that records the financial agreement on divorce. Essentially, it records how couples have decided to split their financial assets, and is usually prepared by a solicitor and signed off by the court.

### **Obtaining an Order**

The more straightforward method involves the parting couple agreeing how they want to split their financial assets and then informing a solicitor, who will draft the Consent Order. Without agreement, divorcing couples may need to undergo financial disclosure via solicitors or attend mediation to reach a settlement that all parties are happy with. If no agreement can be reached, it is open to either party to issue a financial application at court. Whatever decision the court makes in terms of how assets are to be divided, is binding.

### How long does it take?

The length of the process depends on how quickly an agreement can be reached. If both parties are in agreement, it can be relatively quick. Instigating court proceedings will obviously cause delay and can mean a much lengthier process.

### Cost

The cost of having a solicitor draft a Consent Order very much depends on the complexity of the case. The most straightforward cases could cost between £500 to £2,000, depending on which firm and solicitor is chosen. If financial disclosure and specific legal advice is required, this will see the cost rise. While anyone can technically draft a Consent Order, it is highly recommended that it is done by a solicitor or barrister, to ensure it's legally sound.

# **Embracing Boredom**

# The Importance of Unstructured Time for Kids

o you find yourself stressed about keeping the kids entertained during the school holidays? Everything is so expensive or takes so much planning. So, you might be relieved to know that there is growing evidence to suggest that a little boredom can be highly beneficial for children.

Boredom has long been regarded as a negative experience, but recent research suggests otherwise, particularly when it comes to children. Allowing kids to experience moments of boredom can actually foster their creativity. When children are left to their own devices without structured activities, they are compelled to invent their own entertainment. This unstructured time encourages them to tap into their imagination, problemsolving skills, and resourcefulness, thus fostering creativity and independent thinking.

Boredom also acts as a catalyst for curiosity. When children have idle time, they are more likely to explore their surroundings, ask questions, and seek out new experiences. By allowing moments of boredom, we create an environment that stimulates this curiosity

On the other hand, overschedulina kids' free time can have negative consequences. In today's fast-paced society, children's schedules are often packed with extracurricular activities. playdates, and organized outings. While these activities can offer valuable learning opportunities and social interactions, they can also lead to stress and burnout. Overschedulina also robs children (and their parents) of the chance to unwind, reflect, and engage in activities of their own choosing. It restricts their ability to make decisions and develop a sense of autonomy. Without downtime, children may feel overwhelmed and experience a lack of balance in their lives.

'That's all very well,' you might say, 'But if I didn't schedule all the activities and visits my child would spend six straight weeks playing Mario Kart.' As a parent you do have the option of restricting video and computer time, which would undoubtedly provoke cries of 'I'm bored!' and encourage other forms of play, but then you could just surrender and allow them to unwind in the way they choose. We tend to demonise video games, but they do encourage teamwork, strategy, and problem-solving. Plus, as adults we choose what to do with our downtime, and sometimes we only have the emotional energy to binge-watch Netflix! Why should we deny our kids the same luxury? If you are concerned about sedentary screen time, maybe insist that for every two hours they play video games they spend two hours doing something active outside instead.

Embracing a bit of boredom during the school holidays can have a positive impact on children's creativity and curiosity. By striking a balance and embracing the power of boredom, parents can provide their children with a well-rounded and enriching holiday experience, as well as reducing their own stress levels.



# A Long Way from Home by Peter Carey

Willie Bachhuber is their troubled and brilliant



Relationships gradually become strained and alliances shift, as long-hidden secrets and insecurities bubble to the surface.

As the race progresses, the characters' personal journeys intertwine with the larger narrative of a nation struggling to find its identity. Carey uses The Redex Trial as a metaphorical representation of Australia's cultural and social landscape, mirroring the country's quest for a unified identity in the face of its diverse heritage. He weaves together themes of identity, belonging and the legacy of colonialism in a thought-provoking novel from which all three characters emerge changed forever.

charming works that is destined to be loved forever. Mr. Gumpy decides to take a ride in his car. As he sets out on his journey he comes across different animals who all ask to join him. They are the Rabbit, the Cat, the Dog, the Pig, the Sheep, the Chickens, the Calf, the Goat, and the Children. Mr. Gumpy greets them all patiently and cheerfully, though they prove to be quite a rowdy bunch of passengers. When they reach a tricky hill Mr. Gumpy asks for a volunteer to help push the car, but everyone has an excuse as to why they can't do it, then it starts to rain, and the car becomes stuck. The passengers eventually realise that if they don't pull together (or rather push together) they will never get home.

The story is deceptively simple and satisfying, which adds to its appeal. Burningham was known for his illustrations, and they are absolutely beautiful. The combination of earthy colours and whimsical characters make the images warm and inviting, and his use of crosshatching adds movement and life to the story. You can see the animals and children jostling for position in the car. The book's message about the importance of staying calm and working together to overcome adversity is a positive one, endearingly told.

# **Sun Safety Essentials**
