

Don't let inheritance tax spoil your family christmas

Giving to loved ones is a Christmas tradition that everyone enjoys, whether a shopping voucher or a car; it always adds a bit of extra cheer to the holiday. However, for people who like to splash out on their gifts, inheritance tax (IHT) can put a dampener on things. Hannah Tait, partner at Shakespeare Martineau in Solihull, explains.

What is IHT?

Quite simply, it is a tax levied on assets acquired through an inheritance or gift.

What's the tax-free limit for gifts and are any gifts exempt?

Annual lifetime transfers of up to £3,000 can be made each tax year without worrying about inheritance tax. Small gifts of up to £250 can also be made to as many people as you like. This can be very useful for Christmas! Donations to charity and some gifts in consideration of marriages or civil partnerships are not liable for inheritance tax, depending on how closely related a person is to the happy couple. Gifts of £5,000, for example, can be made by a parent and £2,500 can be made by a grandparent. All gifts between married couples or those in civil partnerships are generally also exempt, although it is important that domicile is considered here.

What's the seven-year-rule?

Most gifts will initially be considered as 'potentially exempt transfers'. These become totally exempt when the donor has survived seven years from the date of the gift. If you die within seven years of the potentially exempt transfer, the value eats into your Nil Rate Band (currently £325k per person), thus reducing or even eliminating the amount that can be passed to your beneficiaries without IHT implications.

Is there a way to avoid IHT for certain?

No one can predict how long someone will live. However, early planning is recommended and it is always important to consider the capital gains tax implications of any gift as well as the IHT position. One often overlooked option for IHT is the 'normal expenditure of out income' exemption. If a person can prove their income meets all their living costs, and that their standard of living can be maintained after the gift has been made, then it may be possible to claim this exemption for IHT. To qualify, there must be a regular pattern to this gifting and maintaining records is crucial for the claiming of this very useful exemption. People often use this for the payment of school fees.

The Christmas Mystery

Gaarder, is an author renowned for weaving intricate philosophical musings into compelling narratives. His best-known novel is probably Sophie's World, but here he gifts readers with a story, that at

A Song Through Time The Enduring Tradition of Christmas Carolling

hristmas carolling, the beloved tradition that heralds the festive season, is steeped in history, and has evolved over centuries. It is an embodiment of communal spirit, joy, and the celebration of Christmas through song and verse.

The origins of carolling can be traced back to the pagan celebrations of the Winter Solstice. People would dance and sing to commemorate the passing of the shortest day of the year, celebrating the impending return of the sun. As Christianity spread across Europe, these customs were absorbed into the Christian traditions, particularly the celebration of Christmas.

The word 'carol' originally meant a dance or a song of praise and joy, and carols were not necessarily associated with Christmas. They frowned upon the frivolity and celebrations associated with Christmas, leading to a suppression of carols and public festivities. However, the tradition did not die out entirely and continued in more subdued forms.

The Victorian era marked a significant revival of Christmas traditions, including carolling. The publication of 'Christmas Carols Ancient and Modern' by William Sandys in 1833, along with Queen Victoria's enthusiasm for Christmas, helped rekindle interest in carols. Songs like God Rest Ye Merry, Gentlemen, The First Noel, and Hark! The Herald Angels Sing became staples of the Christmas repertoire.

In contemporary times, carolling remains very much part of Christmas celebrations. Community choirs sing carols in public spaces, churches hold candlelit carol services, and groups of carollers continue the tradition of singing door-to-door.

The history of Christmas carolling is a tapestry woven through centuries of cultural and religious change but the essence of spreading cheer and goodwill through music has remained unchanged.

recipe time

Tartiflette



This is a decadent, savoury French gratin made with potatoes, salty bacon lardons, onions, and plenty of cheese. It's creamy yet crunchy, making it a perfect cold-weather comfort dish. It is traditionally made with Reblochon, but you can use any other firm washed-rind cheese or any pungent melting cheese like Fonting or Raclette.

Ingredients

1.2kg new/waxy potatoes, we used Charlotte
250 g smoked bacon
lardons or diced pancetta
l large onion, finely sliced
175 ml white wine
l garlic clove, crushed
200 ml crème fraiche
400 g Reblochon cheese (or substitute), chopped into 2cm pieces

Method

Bring a large pan of water to the boil and cook the potatoes for 15-20min, until iust tender. Drain well, rinse briefly under cold water and set aside to cool. Fry the lardons over a medium heat until they are beginning to turn golden. Using a slotted spoon, lift them into a bowl, leaving any fat behind. Add the onions and a pinch of salt to the pan, lower the heat and cook gently for 10min, until softened. Turn up the heat and cook until the onions are become golden. Return the lardons to the pan along with the wine and garlic. Bring to the boil and allow to reduce until most of the liquid has evaporated (about 5 minutes). Set aside to cool to room temperature, then stir in the crème fraîche and add some seasoning. Preheat oven to 200°C (180°C fan) gas mark 6. Slice the cooled potatoes into bite-size pieces, then transfer half of the slices to the base of a 2.5-3 litre ovenproof casserole dish. Spoon over half the crème fraîche mixture, followed by half the cheese. Repeat the layers to use up the other half of the ingredients. Cook in the oven for 20-25min, or until golden and bubbling. Leave to rest for 5min before serving with a green salad.
