

Why you need a divorce financial order to cut all ties with your ex

The landmark case of Wyatt v Vince, where the multimillionaire windfarm tycoon's ex-wife made a successful financial claim 20 years after the divorce, should act as a cautionary tale for anyone thinking of a DIY divorce, Dipika Mistry, Legal Director at Solihull-based law firm, Shakespeare Martineau, explains...

A Divorce Final Order Is Not Enough

A lot of couples who undertake DIY divorces fall into the trap of thinking that the divorce date – or final order – is the end. A divorce final order is NOT a clean break financial order. In reality, without proper protection, financial claims can be made many years later.

Consent Orders

A Consent Order is a document that records the financial agreement on divorce. Essentially, it records how couples have decided to split their financial assets and is usually prepared by a solicitor and signed off by the court.

Obtaining an Order

If the terms of a financial settlement cannot easily be agreed, then divorcing couples have a range of options to resolve matters, for example, mediation, collaborative family law meetings, solicitor led round table meetings, arbitration or setting up private hearings with a Judge outside of the formal court route. Financial disclosure should be a part of all these options. The aim is to reach agreement and have a Consent Order drawn up. If no agreement can be reached, it is open to either party to issue a financial application at court. Whatever decision the Judge at court makes in terms of how assets are to be divided, is set out in a binding Court Order.

How long does it take?

The length of the process depends on how quickly an agreement can be reached. If both parties are in agreement, it can be relatively quick. Instigating court proceedings will obviously cause delay and can mean a much lengthier process with more legal costs.

What are the costs

The cost of having a solicitor draft a Consent Order very much depends on the complexity of the case. If significant levels of financial disclosure and specific legal advice is required, this will see the cost rise. While anyone can technically draft a Consent Order, it is highly recommended that it is done by a solicitor or barrister, to ensure it is legally sound.



Bitter

by Francesca Jakobi

Bitter is Francesca Jakobi's astonishing first novel. It is a captivating exploration of complex family dynamics, narrated with a poignant blend of humour and melancholy.



instance, St. Patrick's Day in Ireland or St. David's Day in Wales are as much about celebrating national heritage as they are about


honouring a patron saint.





Fertiliser

his month the days get longer, and the sun gets stronger...we hope!
However,
March is famously temperamental and if the soil where you are is still wet and cold then it's wise to delay planting and sowing until the temperature rises.

Plant nutrient reserves are low at this time of year so, as the soil warms up, it's time to think about fertiliser.

Many gardeners are a bit frightened of fertiliser. All those chemical symbols on the side of the packet are rather reminiscent of school chemistry lessons. In fact, the basics are quite simple.

NPK - This can be observed on the side of most fertiliser packages. The letters stand for:

N - Nitrogen

P - Phosphorous

K - Potassium

Together these are known as the macro-nutrients and each of them has its own use.

Nitrogen primarily feeds the leafy above-the-ground parts of the plants. Phosphorous promotes strong roots. Potassium makes grass hardier, promotes germination and improves vegetable and fruit yields.

The proportions of each macro-nutrient will be printed on the packet. Equal amounts



of each nutrient make for a good general-purpose fertiliser.

A lawn will need a good balance of nitrogen and phosphorus to guarantee lush green grass with a healthy root system capable of withstanding dry spells. Fruiting plants need higher proportions of potassium.

There are other macronutrients: Carbon, Hydrogen and Oxygen, which plants obtain freely from the air and water; and calcium, magnesium, and sulphur, which should be present in any good general-purpose fertiliser.

Plants also need micronutrients: Iron, Manganese, Zinc, Boron, and Molybdenum. Plants take all these nutrients and build everything they need from scratch, including vitamins. What plants cannot do is absorb vitamins directly from things such as pet food, milk or so-called fertilisers which contain vitamins, proteins, and fats.

So don't be intimidated by fertiliser. Decide what your plants need then read the label. It's easy as ABC..or rather NPK.

Caution!

Don't over-do it! It's best to feed little and offen. Don't fertilise in direct sun or the leaves may scorch. Wait until the soil has warmed. Keep out of reach of children!

Guinness Chocolate Puddings



Indulgent, slightly boozy chocolate puddings. Perfect for St Patrick's Day on March 17th

Ingredients

150g unsalted butter, plus extra for the ramekins 200g dark chocolate (70% cocoa), roughly chopped. 90g golden caster sugar 3 large eggs 90ml Guinness Good quality vanilla, chocolate or salted caramelice cream to serve.

Method

Butter four 9 x 5cm ramekins. Place the butter, chocolate

and a generous pinch of salt into a heatproof bowl. Set over a small pan of barely-simmering water and stir until melted, then remove from the heat and leave to cool a little. Place the sugar and eggs into a large mixing bowl and beat with an electric whisk until pale, doubled in volume and thick enough to leave a trail. Gently fold in the melted chocolate and the Guinness. Spoon the mixture into the ramekins.

then chill in the fridge for 1 hr. In the meantime, place a baking tray on the top shelf of the oven and preheat to 200C/180C fan/gas 6. Place the chilled ramekins on the hot baking tray and bake for 18 mins. Remove from the oven and leave to stand for a minute. The centres will sink a little. Pop a scoop of ice cream into the hollow and serve.

Spring Equinox - March 20th

e hear the terms 'equinox' and 'solstice' bandied about, but what do they actually mean?

These terms both relate to the Earth's orbit around the sun and its axial tilt, but they refer to different phenomena and occur associated with the transition of seasons: the vernal equino

Equinox: This occurs when the sun is exactly above the Equator, causing day and night to be of approximately equal length. This happens twice a year, around March 20-21 (the vernal or spring equinox) and September 22-23 (the autumnal or fall equinox). These dates can vary slightly each year.

During an equinox, the Earth's axis is not tilted toward or away from the sun. As a result, both the Northern and Southern Hemispheres experience roughly equal amounts of daylight and darkness. Equinoxes are often associated with the transition of seasons: the vernal equinox marks the beginning of spring, and the autumnal equinox signifies the start of fall in the respective hemispheres.

Solstice: This occurs when the sun reaches its highest or lowest point in the sky at noon, marked by the longest and shortest days. It happens twice a year, around June 20-21 (the summer solstice) and December 21-22 (the winter solstice).

During a solstice, the Earth's axis is tilted maximally toward (summer solstice) or away (winter solstice) from the sun. This results in the longest day of the year during the summer solstice and the shortest day of the year during the winter solstice in the respective hemispheres.

A History of Easter's Delectable Delights
